For the above-mentioned UCITS funds (the "Funds"), the amendment to the "General Terms and Conditions of Investment" for the UCITS funds managed by Allianz Global Investors GmbH described below will enter into force with effect from **20 July 2025**.

The background to the requested amendment to Section 25 (Dispute resolution procedure) of the "General Terms and Conditions of Investment" is that the European Union is discontinuing its online dispute resolution platform (ODR platform), which supported consumers and companies in resolving disputes out of court, with effect from **20 July 2025**. Until now, companies based in the EU were obliged to provide a link to this platform on their websites. With the switch-off, this information obligation no longer applies.

The full wording of the amended Section 25 (Dispute resolution procedure) of the "General Terms and Conditions of Investment" for the UCITS funds managed by Allianz Global Investors GmbH, which is valid with effect from **20 July 2025**, is reproduced below:

§ Section 25 Dispute resolution procedure

The company has undertaken to participate in dispute resolution proceedings before a consumer arbitration board¹. In the event of disputes, consumers can contact the ombudsman's office for investment funds of the BVI Bundesverband Investment und Asset Management e.V. as the competent consumer arbitration board. The company participates in dispute resolution proceedings before this arbitration board².
